6. Updates:

Repaint the Mardle railings and the phone box in Back Lane

It was felt that now was the time to carry out the painting and it was agreed that a working party would meet on Wednesday 15th and Friday 17th June to undertake the work.

Carl had indicated that he was willing to paint the ‘phone box, Louis to talk to him.

Proposed 20mph speed limit - Back Lane

Signs now up and it becomes legally effective on 15th June 2016.

Road Signs, Proposed picket fences at village entrances and Roundels on Jay Lane

These are now well overdue. Clerk to email Keith Sampson of Suffolk County Council seeking clarification on timescales for the work to be completed.

It was felt that roundels on Jay Lane were not necessary if the “slow” markings which are very faint were re-painted.

7. **106 Money**

The development was Cartshed site, Hall Farm Cottage.

After a brief discussion, it was decided to purchase a plastic table seat for The Heath together with slabs and associated sand and cement.

Clerk to notify Waveney District Council (Lorraine Francis) of intent and seek agreement for the expenditure.

8. **Neighbourhood Planning**

The work is being carried out in collaboration with Somerleyton. The intent is to seek the views of the local communities as to the future requirements of the two parishes. The steering group have sought area designation from Waveney District Council. Monthly meetings are taking place to discuss methodology and move things forward. It is hoped to have a stall at the Lound Festival.

9. **Report from District and County Councillors**

Reports from Councillors had been given at the Annual Parish Meeting.

Devolution was briefly discussed, the first meeting giving information will occur at the end of the month. It is likely to be Norfolk with Suffolk and Cambridge with Peterborough

Waveney District Council are still looking for views on the Local Plan, indications are that Lothingland seems to be one of the few areas that has commented. The deadline for comment is Friday 17th June 2016.

10. Parish Councillor Vacancy

Marina Patterson has reflected an interest in becoming a Councillor but is unwell and will hopefully be at the next meeting in August.

11. Correspondence

A copy of correspondence was available, but most documents had been circulated by email, Peter borrowed the list to read through the documents. Louis pointed out that documentation on the presentation of the Northern Parishes had not been included.

At the Northern Parishes meeting, a representative from the Broads Authority explained how the future of the Broads was going to be managed to encourage more use. An interesting development was the location of several ancient sites which were going to be excavated.
