Somerleyton residents have received a letter from the Somerleyton Estate inviting them to a display in Somerleyton Village Hall. WDC are starting to develop a new Local Plan, and this display will show the Estate's views on how Somerleyton could be developed. It will show areas of land within Somerleyton which have been put forward by the Estate in response to WDC's call for development land.

People from the Somerleyton Estate will be there to explain their proposals.

The meeting discussed this letter, and decided that no immediate response was needed. Most people present said they would go to Somerleyton Village Hall to see what was being proposed.

Neighbourhood Planning is a process for gathering and recording the views of the local community. Although we are only just starting the Neighbourhood Planning process it is hoped that we will be able to collect local resident's views so they can be taken into account in WDC's Local Plan.

The first step in producing a Neighbourhood Plan is to ask WDC to formally designate a Neighbourhood Area. The form requesting this was partially completed – Jenni took it away to complete it in conjunction with Somerleyton Parish Council.
